MINUTE OF ASSOCIATE LESTER


[1] The applicant is the liquidator of Corbel Construction Limited (In Liquidation). In this proceeding he is seeking orders appointing him the liquidator of assets held on trust by Corbel and for directions as to how to manage and distribute those assets.

[2] He has applied for directions:

- (a) For leave to commence this application by originating application (if such leave is required);
- (b) Orders as to service of the application;
- (c) Timetabling of the application.

[3] I have read the originating application, memorandum of counsel and the affidavit of Mr Oorschot and direct as follows:

- (a) I grant leave to the applicant to commence this proceeding by originating application under Part 19 High Court Rules;
- (b) I direct that service of the application, affidavit of Mr Oorschot and memorandum of counsel along with this Minute be served upon all of the 51 affected subcontractors and that service may be effected upon them in the following manner:
 - (i) By sending the said documents to the email addresses of the subcontractors and by providing a link to the web page indicated for the Ashton Wheelans website;
 - (ii) For any subcontractor where such email is returned undelivered, by sending the documents by courier to the registered office or last known address of the said subcontractor;
- (c) That any subcontractor who wishes to be joined as a party to this proceeding may apply to do so within 15 working days of service;
- (d) That there shall be a telephone conference convened on **30 October 2019 at 9.00 am** before me to timetable this application to a hearing. Applicant's counsel is to advise the sub-contractors to be served that any application to be joined will be given that telephone conference date as its first call date, with any opposition to joinder to be filed and served prior to the conference. If there are opposed applications counsel are to confer on the directions to be sought at the conference and file a joint memorandum **5 days prior**.
